Competition Style Marching Band

We are a "competition style" marching band. In addition to performing and supporting our football team at all football games, we compete throughout the state and nationally during the fall.

We focus on one very complex show that typically is not fully complete until mid October.

Indianapolis Super Regional Info - Saturday, 10/23

 For those new to the program, the Indianapolis Super Regional is one of the largest marching band competitions in the country. Because of its location, it brings in bands from several states across the country. Lucas Oil Stadium also hosts Grand Nationals in mid-November each year, so many bands elect to attend this Super Regional to get experience in the venue before Grand Nationals. Typical Bands of America regionals (like Obetz) pull in 15-20 bands. A Super Regional is typically a multi-day event and pull in 60-80 competing bands. It's a **BIG** deal. Similar to Obetz, if the band scores in the top 14 spots (regardless of class), earn the chance to perform in finals on the evening of 10/23. Should the WK Marching Band make finals at this event, it will be a very late return time from Indianapolis.



Varsity Block



What is Varsity Block?

Developmental role for members of the band who may need additional time and experience prior to marching all performing events.

Varsity Block members perform drill at all football games and potentially for some competitions.

Members could fill openings should an injury occur.

Typically, after one season, Varsity Block members should move into our competition drill as long as they are ready.

Varsity Block



How students are evaluated:

Rookie Days, Spring Camp and July 4 Rehearsals

Evaluated throughout the season for readiness to jump into a spot, regardless of instrument.

Decisions will be made by our first week of band camp starting on July 15.

There is a possibility of Varsity Block students jumping into Parts 2 and 3 of the show if we see that they are ready to do so before the drill is written

Registration Process

Marching Band General Fee: \$475

This fee helps offset the total cost of band camp, camp meals, equipment, staffing, music arranging, copyright permissions, competition fees, drill writing, transportation competition meals, costuming, uniforms, show shirts, equipment, props, and all other miscellaneous expenses associated with the operation of the marching program. The emainder of the individual student cost to participate is subsidized by fundraisers coordinated by our Band Booster organization. This fee covers the entire season from pring activities in May through the end of the season in November with the exception of any overnight trips.

Uniform Fees: Variable

Rookie Pack: \$150 (FIRST YEAR MEMBERS ONLY) This will include all uniform and miscellaneous items a new member will need including a duffle bag, 2 competition uniform undershirts, summer uniform shirt and shorts, marching shoes and water jug. 1st year color guard members will receive slightly lifferent items (including the guard warm-up), but the Rookie Pack will cover all needs for guard members. The Rookie Pack is discounted and is only vailable for our first year marching band members

Replacement Uniform Items: (RETURNING MEMBERS ONLY) Individual replacement uniform items including marching shoes, summer uniform shirts and shorts, competition uniform undershirt (black WK shirt), color guard warm-ups, These items will only need to be purchased is they were lost or not acquire rom previous seasons. ***Please note, we have acquired new water jugs and all returning members will get a replacement water jug for the 2024 season.

Miscellaneous Fees: Variable

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Senior Banner (Seniors Only), Duffle Bag, Water Jug, Stick/Mallet Fees (Percussionists Only) Co-Curricular Fee: \$85 (Due first week of August on MyPaymentsPlus)

- We have calculated the actual cost per participant for marching band to be about <u>\$1,400</u>. This means that our music boosters work to subsidize costs of the organization by over \$900 per student by the fundraising that we do! We hope you will consider volunteering!

- Parents volunteering in this capacity will help serve and/or prepare meals at band camp and competitions.

Even though we have uniform coordinators in place, we need many hands to make light work! Please consider helping with
uniforms as there is always much to do. We have fittings that happen in the spring and we need parents to hem pants,
organize, and eventually wash. Sewing experience is not required to help with uniforms as there are other things parents
can help with.

 $\hfill\square$ Tag Day Drivers (One of our MOST important fundraisers!)

Tag Day is our single most important fundraiser of the year that brings in about \$17,000 for our band program. We need drivers to help make this happen! More drivers helps us cover more routes. Parents that volunteer accompany a group of 4 students on a specific route. They drive them to the route and follow (in air conditioned cars) to ensure safety of the group.
 Parents volunteering in this capacity must be willing to get a \$50 background check through the school since they will be driving students. This is different than the free bagte that parents need to volunteer. This check would be good for several years and also allows parents to be overnight certified for any trips we might do during your student's time in the program.

- Tag Day Organization
- Help to organize buckets, envelopes, route assignments, signups, count money, etc

Football Game Parking

 Our band manages parking at home football games and parking volunteers help collect money and direct traffic. We typically have 5 home games throughout the season and this fundraiser brings in around \$3,000 for our band program!

Chaperone (Football Games/Competitions/Parades)

Chaperones are <u>EXTREMELY</u> important to the success of our program. We have several chaperones present at every
football game (home and away) as well as all of our competitions. Chaperones help with general needs and function as an
adult presence when we travel.

Band Camp Chaperone

 Band camp is a long week with extended rehearsals. During this week, we have parent chaperones that take shifts to help be on call to help with student needs that might arise. These parents help with water, ice, and are on call in case we have any students that have hear leated issues or are injured.

□ Pit Crew (Football Games/Competitions)

As a competition band, we have A LOT of equipment that we need help with to get on and off the field. We have drum
major podiums, ladders, mallet percussion equipment, speakers, synth carts, generators, and much more. This elite group of
special forces help ensure our equipment gets on and off the field for our football game and competition performances.

Props/Equipment/Misc.

We also have many props that we use throughout the season. Do you have building experience? Like to paint? Like to help
with miscellaneous tasks that ensure our band to have a successful performance?






