## Disney Packing Info

### *Each student may bring no more than the following items:*

- One Medium sized Suitcase (should not exceed 24" by 36")
- WK Duffle Bag as their Carry-on (will contain all uniform parts)
- Backpack - Students are responsible for all missed work. Use the bus ride wisely!
- One Band Garment bag – Will be provided with your uniform before we leave.
- Instrument cleaned and in good working condition
- Pillow and Blanket for bus (optional)

### **Duffle Items**

- Toiletries for travel and to freshen up before arrival at Epcot (deodorant, toothbrush/paste, etc.)
- Money for meal stops
- Extra masks
- **Change of clothes and whatever you need for our first day in the park.**
  - Students should plan to wear what they have on the bus or a bring a change of clothes in their duffles with them. In addition, students should have everything they need for the day in the park in their duffle. Students will NOT have the opportunity to get to their luggage under the bus until we arrive at the hotel. This could include money, sunglasses, jacket, battery charger, or anything else students might want with them for our first day in the park. Please plan accordingly.
- Battery charger. We are highly recommending students have battery chargers with them.
- Snacks... lots of snacks!
- Dinner - We are advising all students to bring dinner with them to eat on the bus.
- Coat, jacket or sweatshirt
- Stuff to do on the bus (Great opportunity for students to complete schoolwork they will miss)
- **ALL UNIFORM ACCESSORIES**
  - Shako, hat wrap, shoes, gloves, MB undershirt, long black socks, hair supplies
  - Guard members should have all accessories for their uniforms.
- Students can also bring a separate book bag if desired for school work.

### **Suggested Suitcase Items:**

- Additional toiletries
- Soap, Shampoo & Conditioner (provided at the hotel, but optional to bring)
- Brush, comb, hair supplies
- Sunscreen
- Extra masks (we recommend bringing several for the trip!)
- Contact lenses and supplies and/or glasses. Having extra contacts is always a good idea.
- Approved prescription medications with proper paperwork completed with the school.
- Cosmetics (if not in Carry-on bag)
- Clothing – Look at itinerary and weather report and plan clothing accordingly.
- Swimsuit - Our hotel has a pool!
- Spending money; families determine amount needed. Consider meals that are not included and souvenirs you may buy. Debit Cards/VISA Gift Cards recommended.
- Coat, Raincoat or Poncho
- Student ID/Driver License
