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## Competition Style Marching Band







Registering online keeps all of our registration information in one place and saves us time processing student registrations. Once registered, there are links to pay fees online to complete your registration.

Payment in full - OR - initial \$125 payment #1 AND uniform fees/misc. fees are required to complete your registration.

We, student and parent(s), have read the information contained in this form for the Worthington Kilbourne High School Marching Band. By signing this contract, we are making a **commitment** to join this organization. We understand that by joining this organization, the student agrees to abide by all the rules of our band handbook (found on our website) and school. We understand that being a member of such an elite ensemble is a privilege and not a right. Furthermore, the student plans to attend every scheduled rehearsal and performance throughout the summer and fall as listed on the official calendar of the marching band. We understand that should a student decide to leave the WKMB, the Cancellation Policy found in our marching band handbook shall be adhered to strictly without exception. We understand that the student agrees to follow the established Co-Curricular Drug and Alcohol Policy and maintain academic eligibility requirements set forth by the Worthington City Schools administration. We understand that the student must provide a completed physical to be eligible to participate. We also understand that we will be responsible for payment of any lost or damaged uniforms/parts for the uniform assigned to the student. We understand that failure to observe these terms may result in the student not being able to participate in some or all of our marching band events, performances or rehearsals.

# Final Forms

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All WKMB students must enroll in Final Forms prior to the beginning of the season. Don't worry about this right now!

Instructions will be emailed and sent through the Tuesday Blurb and will be discussed in detail during our Spring Camp.

As part of Final Forms, all members will need to have a current physical on file to participate. Please schedule this in the spring with your doctor or be on the lookout for Ohio Health's free sports physicals!

# Fees

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- **Our 2026 General Fee is \$625**
- General Fees include the cost of: drill writing, wind book arranging, battery and front ensemble arranging, copyright permissions, transportation costs, competition fees, show design, uniform costs, rain coats, guard warm ups, gloves, uniform parts, band camp meals, band camp staff, season staffing, competition meals, band camp meals, equipment, drum heads, mallets and accessories, field equipment, dot books, dots, supplies, student support, show props, show shirts, competition uniforms, booster sponsored events and more!
- We have calculated the actual cost per participant for marching band to be about **\$2,000**. This means that our music boosters work to subsidize costs of the organization of about \$1,400 per student by the fundraising that we do! We hope you will consider volunteering!

# Co-Curricular Fees

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The Co-Curricular Fee for participate in any Worthington sport or activity in the district is \$85.

This is a **SEPARATE** fee due in mid-August paid to Worthington Schools.

Co-Curricular are paid directly to Worthington Schools and the fee will be automatically go on your MyPayments Plus in August.

# Forms



## Fee Payment Form (Yellow)

This form explains the fee structure of the marching band and details each fee category.

### 1st Year Members

Should pay the general fee and the Rookie Pack fee. This will cover all needed items to participate.

### Percussion Families

Must also pay the stick/mallet fee for consumable supplies.

### Senior Families

Must also pay the Senior Banner fee.

## 2026 MB FEE PAYMENT FORM Worthington Kilbourne Marching Band

### Marching Band General Fee: \$625

This fee helps offset the total cost of the season including band camp expenses, camp meals, equipment, staffing, music arranging, copyright permissions, competition fees, drill writing, transportation, competition meals, winds and guard costumes, uniforms, show shirts, equipment, props, and all other miscellaneous expenses associated with the operation of the marching program. The remainder of the individual student cost to participate is subsidized by fundraisers coordinated by our Band Booster organization. This fee covers the entire season from spring activities in May through the end of the season in November with the exception of overnight trips.

### Uniform Fees: Variable

Rookie Pack: \$175 (FIRST YEAR MEMBERS ONLY) This will include all uniform and miscellaneous items a new member will need including a duffel bag, 2 competition uniform undershirts, summer uniform shirt and shorts, marching shoes and water jug. 1st year color guard members will receive slightly different items (including the guard warm-up), but the Rookie Pack will cover all needs for guard members. The Rookie Pack is discounted and is only available for our first year marching band members.

Replacement Uniform Items: (RETURNING MEMBERS ONLY) Individual replacement uniform items including marching shoes, summer uniform shirts and shorts, competition uniform undershirt (black WK shirt), color guard warm-ups. These items will only need to be purchased if they were lost or not acquired from previous seasons.

### Miscellaneous Fees: Variable

Senior Banner (Seniors Only), Duffel Bag and Water Jug (RETURNING MEMBERS ONLY), Stick/Mallet Fees (Percussionists Only)

### Co-Curricular Fee: \$85 (Due in mid August on MyPaymentsPlus)

This is a district-wide general fee for ALL co-curricular activities. This fee is paid directly to Worthington Schools and is not due until the first week of August. It will appear on your MyPaymentsPlus account. Please **DO NOT** include this in your payment for Marching Band registration.

- Preparing/Serving Meals (Band Camp and Competitions)**
  - Parents volunteering in this capacity will help serve and/or prepare meals at band camp and competitions.
- Uniforms (Hemming, fittings, washing, organizing, distributing)**
  - Even though we have uniform coordinators in place, we need many hands to make light work! Please consider helping with uniforms as there is always much to do. We have fittings that happen in the spring and we need parents to hem pants, organize, and eventually wash. Sewing experience is not required to help with uniforms as there are other things parents can help with.
- Tag Day Drivers (One of our MOST important fundraisers!)**
  - Tag Day is our single most important fundraiser of the year that brings in about \$20,000 for our band program. We need drivers to help make this happen! More drivers helps us cover more routes. Parents that volunteer accompany a group of 4 students on a specific route. They drive them to the route and follow (in air conditioned cars!) to ensure safety of the group.
  - Parents volunteering in this capacity must be willing to get a \$50 background check through the school since they will be driving students. This is different than the free badge that parents need to volunteer. This check would be good for several years and also allows parents to be overnight certified for any trips we might do during your student's time in the program.
- Tag Day Organization**
  - Help to organize buckets, envelopes, route assignments, signups, count money, etc.
- Football Game Parking**
  - Our band manages parking at home football games and parking volunteers help collect money and direct traffic. We typically have 5 home games throughout the season and this fundraiser brings in around \$3,000 for our band program!
- Chaperone (Football Games/Competitions/Parades)**
  - Chaperones are **EXTREMELY** important to the success of our program. We have several chaperones present at every football game (home and away) as well as all of our competitions. Chaperones help with general needs and function as an adult presence when we travel.
- Band Camp Chaperone**
  - Band camp is a long week with extended rehearsals. During this week, we have parent chaperones that take shifts to help be on call to help with student needs that might arise. These parents help with water, ice, and are on call in case we have any students that have heat related issues or are injured.
- Pit Crew (Football Games/Competitions)**
  - As a competition band, we have A LOT of equipment that we need help with to get on and off the field. We have drum major podiums, ladders, mallet percussion equipment, speakers, synth carts, generators, and much more. This elite group of special forces help ensure our equipment gets on and off the field for our football game and competition performances.
- Props/Equipment/Misc.**
  - We also have many props that we use throughout the season. Do you have building experience? Like to paint? Like to help with miscellaneous tasks that ensure our band to have a successful performance?
- Corporate Sponsorships**
  - We are in need of several parents to help reach out to local businesses to recruit for our corporate sponsorship program.
- BINGO Events**
  - Our band boosters host 4 BINGO events each school year. There are several volunteering opportunities in this realm including: ticketing, concessions, bake sale, raffle ticket/instant bingo ticket sales, organization/planning, setup/teardown.
